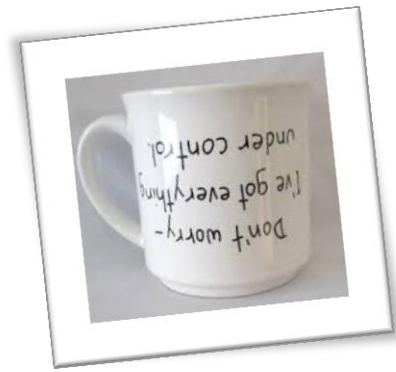




Feb & March Month-end Report
