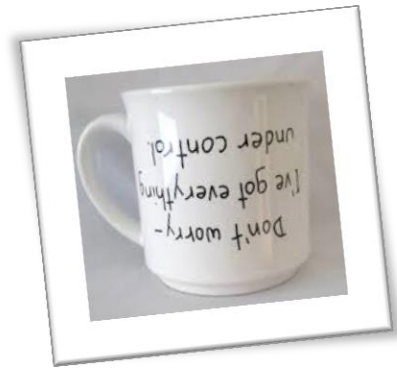




April Month-end – Mid-May Report
