- \$6000 potential partnership with the Empowering Youth Grant with Idaho Coalition Against Sexual &Domestic Violence – will know by September 2015
- SBE's Educate Idaho program manager is looking into what he can do to help cover ½ of the costs of our interactive directory, this could be a \$7,000 -\$10,000 partnership.
- All MOUs have been signed by Jannus team—just waiting for final signature from the City.
- Talked to Ericka Rupp of IDHW (ICCP and TANF) about a partnership – Sent more formal proposal in May, and sent follow up 6/19
