AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STEM ACTION CENTER BOARD; AMENDING CHAPTER 8, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-825, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS REGARDING THE STEM ACTION CENTER BOARD'S MEETINGS, HONORARIUM AND EXPENSES, AND ORGANIZATION.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 8, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and designated as Section 67-825, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

67-825. STEM ACTION CENTER BOARD -- MEETINGS -- HONORARIUM AND EXPENSES -- ORGANIZATION. (1) The STEM action center board shall hold no fewer than four (4) regular meetings annually at such time and place as may be directed by the board. Special meetings may be called by the chair at any time and place designated in such call.

(2) Each member shall be compensated as provided in section 59-509(c), Idaho Code.

(3) At its first meeting after the first day of July in each year, the STEM action center board shall organize and shall elect from its membership a chairperson and a vice chairperson.
